

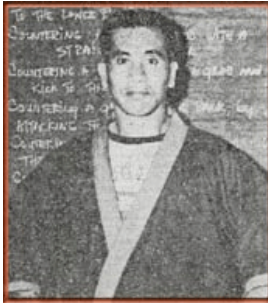

GRANDMASTER'S CORNER:

Hello everyone:

Boy, how the time flies as we are into a new year already and I really don't know where the old one has gone. Whatever the case, I am so happy to have all of my students and instructors striving for the same things in life and I am truly proud of their achievements and successes. Never in an organization have they seen such dedication and devotion especially to Professor Chow's art. I have heard many things from others bickering on how this is not Professor Chow's Art, but you all can rest assured as I live that it is and always has been. Master Kuheana, who I continually converse with, made the comment, that people are just jealous and when they live lies, and then they have to pull down others to make themselves look good.

It reminds me of a conversation with Professor Chow many years ago when he was going to promote me and I told him that I was not ready and that if he did, many people would make bad comments and this is what he said. "The problem with people is that they are like the black crabs on the rocks. If you catch a bunch and throw them into a can, rather than they all help each other get out, as one starts to crawl out, others will grab a hold of him and pull him back into the can." We have grown immensely and I can honestly say, I have not made any money from the system nor use his name for any monetary gain. So those that make claims of the same...all I can say is...sleep on that and pray that it doesn't come back to bite you in the okole later on.

There has been a rumor going around that I was involved in a confrontation with another person at Hanshi Bruce Juchnik's Gathering in Sacramento and that Sensei Al Parker had to jump in the middle to break us up. So we as students are donating the entire amount to pay for the costs of this memorial (which is around \$18,000) for both. To me that is what giving back is all about,

not putting a single dime back into my pocket for the namesake of a person that left us so much. We students of the Chinese Kara-Ho Kempo Karate System don't believe in talking false claims...but I think it is said that we put our money where our mouth is. It is amazing that even his own couple students that he had upon his passing never did anything for him or his widow. As Professor Chow would always tell me that many people speak with forked tongue.

This 20th memorial year will also have available collective coins with his photo (never seen before) on the front with the dates and on the back will be the first Kara-Ho Symbol (which of course I have in my possession) all in color. Commemorative watches will also be available with these same photos. The costs will be the exact amount costing us with a limit of 10 per person for instructor's only. Students can obtain them from their respective instructors. There will only be a limited amount available and after that the dye will be destroyed. Those that donate at least \$250 as an individual for this memorial will receive a hand-carved 3 dimensional plaque of the Kara-Ho Symbol with an appreciation for your donation. We hope that you will all donate allot more then that. If there is any extra from this donation, then we will use that money to offset the luau that we are having that night with Dr. Perry as a guest speaker. A writer/photographer will also be on hand to do a feature article of Dr. Perry and also of this event. We were notified that the Hawaiian Martial Arts Society will be doing their Hall of Fame (HOF) at the same time on the Sunday evening (23rd) so we are all invited. Sensei Ka'imi, Dr. Perry, Master Kuheana and myself are all being inducted into the Hawaiian Martial Arts HOF. The possibility of having the Mayor and the Governor of our great state might be in attendance. What a tribute to a man who left us so much and asked for nothing in return. I have had Sensei John send out a special e-mail regarding our travel agent for the travel flights and so you can all check to see whether the costs are effective for you. This is something none will want to miss as we hope that we can pay our last respect to Professor Chow's ashes prior to it resting back into the ground. A dedication of the grave will happen at that time. This is what they refer to as a true memorial!

Now for the update of what's been happening here. We had great traveling experiences to Montana, Washington and Germany in the very recent months and enjoyed ourselves at every area. Washington even got me to make some BBQ on the grill (the talents my mother left me year ago). I also enjoyed visiting my properties in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho and now the factor of putting a log house on one of those properties. Going to Hawaii also was a trip as I trained with Shihan Kahananui and his student. We got to go to the Big Island and visit my property on the Big Island. One that had a 360-degree view of the ocean. Then we just got back from Las Vegas and Utah where I had an opportunity to visit with my two uncles and also a very good friend, Sid Liufau, a Lima Lama instructor. It is always great to spend quality time with loved ones.



But the highlight of the trip was to attend the LDS Temple in Salt Lake City with my oldest daughter (who received her black belt from Professor Chow himself at the age of 16), get sealed with her husband and daughter, Jazzy. What a beautiful moment to know that we can all be together as a family for time and all eternity.



I had an opportunity to spend a belated Christmas with all my grand children (12 of them) and my daughters. What an enjoyable time I had to see the excitement in their manner and faces and to even see family that I haven't seen in a while. Shihan, Dr. Chris Mendoza is the highest ranking student/instructor under Grandmaster Kuoha in Kara-Ho Kempo at 6th Dan. He originally began training at a young age with Shihan Ben Kahananui in Lakeside, CA. Sensei Mike Chavez (1st Dan) and myself had the opportunity to both watch him in action and "feel" the techniques that he was working on at the El Cajon Dojo over the holidays. Grandmaster Kuoha had a potluck dinner on Wednesday, December 28th, 2005 in honor of Shihan Mendoza and Shihan Kahananui's visit to the Kara-Ho "Headquarters".

It was a great honor to have Shihan Mendoza attend the Wednesday night class, and he was generous with his time working his way through the dojo, giving tips on technique to members of all ranks during the class. It was not unusual to have all activity in the dojo suddenly stop when Shihan was demonstrating a technique.
